

### **TURTLE WALK GUIDELINES**

### **Location:**

Coconut Point Park aka Val Steele Park 3535 S. Hwy A1A, Melbourne Beach, FL 32951

**Sea Turtle Biology and Conservation Presentation:** Begins at **9:00 PM**. Please **arrive by 8:55 PM**.

#### ABOUT THE EXPERIENCE

- ☼ During the presentation, scouts trained to locate nesting female Loggerhead turtles will begin their search. They will communicate with the night walk leader once a turtle is located.
- \* Restrooms are available at Coconut Point Park. Opportunities to use them will be granted before or after the nesting event.
- - Bringing a water bottle
  - Preparing for wet feet
  - Wearing protective shoes (to guard against sharp objects)
- $\Rightarrow$  We must stay **together as a group** at all times walking down together and returning together to avoid disturbing nesting turtles.
- ❖ After the female turtle returns to the ocean, our leader will guide us back to Coconut Point Park. The walk typically ends around **midnight**, but could extend until **1:00 AM**.
- ☼ Please wear lightweight, dark or tan comfortable clothing with sleeves and long pants for bug protection. Bug spray is permitted.

# **A What NOT to bring or do:**

• No flashlights, flash photography, or any items that emit flashes.



- No smoking.
- No cell phone use during the walk.
- This is a guided experience please follow your guide's instructions at all times.
